Teaching has been of increasing interest to me this year, and I tutor second, third and six grades in music and mathematics at Dixie Canyon Elementary School as part of a special volunteer program. I also have a job at the Beverly Hills Cotillion instructing ten classes a week in ballroom

and modern dancing. The classes include instruction in the social graces and etiquette.

In spite of all these indoor interests, I consider myself more of an outdoor person than an indoor person, and enjoy spending time in our National Parks and Forests. I enjoy golf, water skiing and hiking.

On the scholastic side, I am a Semifinalist in the National Merit Scholarship Competition.

My field of interests continues to grow.
